(One beat)

[G] Oh! my old man's a dustman he wears a dustman's [D7] hat  
[D7] He wears gor blimey trousers and he lives in a council [G] flat (Low strum)  
(spoken)

I say I say I say - What has 4 wheels and flies"

**I don know,wot as 4 wheels and flizz....."Your bin lorry "**

[G] Though my old man's a dustman he's got a heart of [D7] gold  
[D7] He got married recently though he's 86 years [G] old  
[G] C We said 'Ear! Hang on Dad you're [G7] getting past your prime'  
(One beat)  
[D7] (Stop) He said 'Well when you get to my age it helps to pass the time'

[G] Oh! my old man's a dustman he wears a dustman's [D7] hat  
[D7] He wears gor blimey trousers and he lives in a council [G] flat (Low strum)  
(spoken)

I say I say I say - I've had a scouser in my garden"

**Ow dyow know it wuz a scowsa**"My wheelie bin was up on bricks"

[G] Now one day while in a hurry he missed a lady's [D7] bin  
[D7] He hadn't gone but a few yards when she chased after [G] him  
[G]'What game do you think you're playing' she [G7] cried right from the [C]  
heart,

(One beat) (Leader only)

[D7] (Stop) 'You've missed me...am I too late?'

(All) 'No... jump up on the cart'

[G] Oh! my old man's a dustman he wears a dustman's [D7] hat  
[D7] He wears gor blimey trousers and he lives in a council [G] flat (Low strum)  
(spoken)

I say I say I say.....**Not yo agen, ..where's yowa bin**

Non of your business, but if you must know,I've bin in the loo

**No...I ment where's yowa Wheely Bin"**

OK- I've Wheely Bin in bed with the maid

[G] He found a tiger's head one day, nailed to a piece of [D7] wood  
[D7] The tiger looked quite miserable but I suppose it [G] should  
[G] Just then from out a window, a [G7] voice began to [C] wail

(One beat) (Leader only)

[D7] (Stop) He said Oi! Where's me tiger head

(All) Four foot from it's tail

[G] Oh! my old man's a dustman he wears a dustman's [D7] hat  
[D7] He wears gor blimey trousers and he lives in a council [G] flat  
[G] Next time you see a dustman [G7] looking all pale and [C] sad

(One beat)

(Off Beats)

[D7] (Stop) Don't kick him in the dustbin it might ----be--- my----old---
