

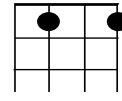

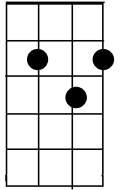

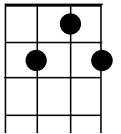

(G) When I was just a baby my mama told me. Son,

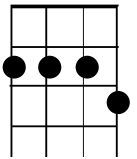
Always be a good boy, don't (G7) ever play with guns.

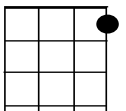
(G) I bet there's rich folks eating from a fancy dining car
