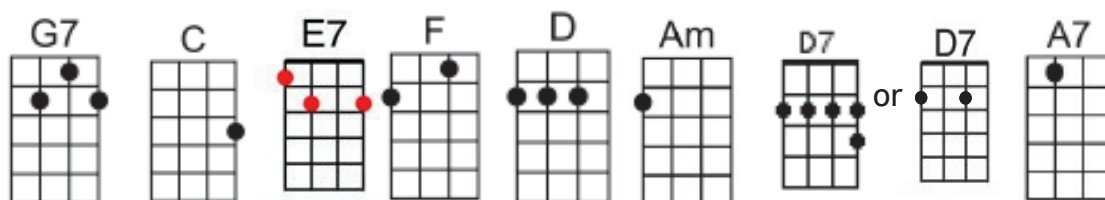


There'll Always Be An England
